

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ADMITTANCE

Purpose:

To outline the procedures for international student admissions

Scope:

Administrators and international students/parents

Policy:

Khalsa School accepts international students provided the school has adequate facilities, personnel and resources to accommodate the needs of the student and that fees for our international program are paid upon registration. Fees for the 2016-2017 school year are \$10,000.

Procedures:

Administrators will review the student's application, including prior school reports, to determine suitability with our program of study. At the administrator's discretion, a Letter of Acceptance may be offered for a fee of \$500 to support the student's immigration process. A valid Study Permit and medical coverage is required of all international students.

International students are expected to:

- Adhere to Khalsa School's rules, regulations and expectations and uphold our mission, vision, and values.
- Reapply annually for admission.
- Pay an additional charge if learning support is needed beyond the needs disclosed at the time of registration.
- If an international student is not living with parent(s), a local guardian over 25 years of age must be appointed who will take responsibility for the student and ensure that all necessities of living are provided (food clothing, transportation, etc.)
- Adhere to Homestay guidelines if applicable.
